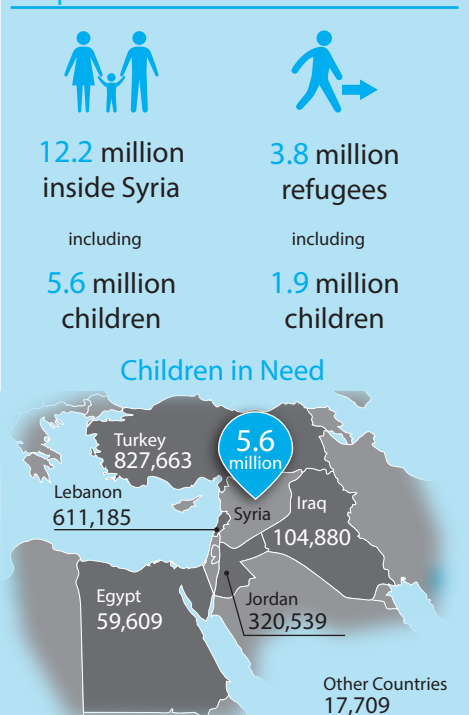


UNICEF received 64% of funding against the Syria SHARP and sub-regional RRP6 appeals for 2014, Turkey was the most under-funded country with a 50% funding gap against the appeal. UNICEF in Syria had a year end funding gap of over US\$68 million. Education was the least funded sector with only 50% of funds received for the year 2014.

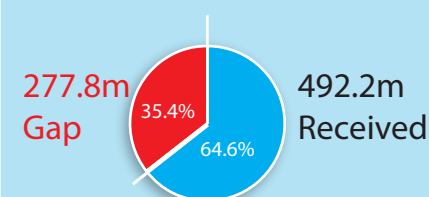
The No Lost Generation was a catalytic initiative in 2014, supporting children maintain normalcy. The region-wide coordinated polio vaccination campaigns have been successful in stopping new transmission of cases. However children's needs continue to rise across the region with the conflict due to enter it's fifth year in March 2015.

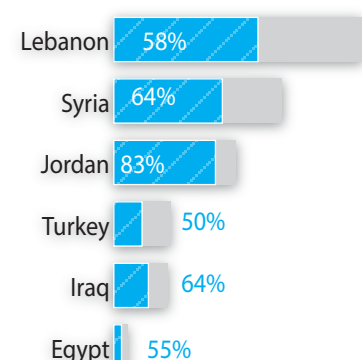


UNICEF Funding Requirements 2014

Funding Status per Country - % Funded

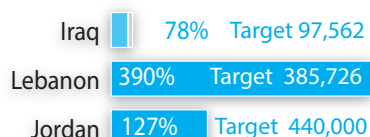

Water

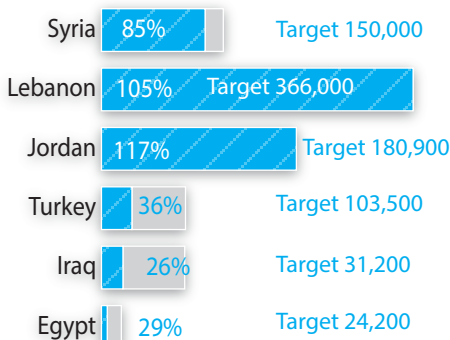
In Syria, UNICEF is providing water treatment supplies that treat enough water to serve over **16.55 million** people.

In neighboring countries, **2,167,119** people have been provided with access to drinking and domestic water.



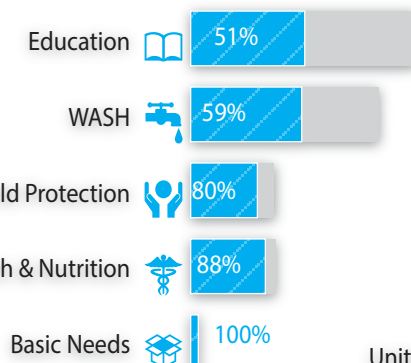
Child Protection

822,415 children with access to psychosocial support services.



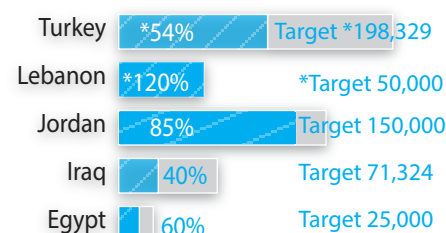

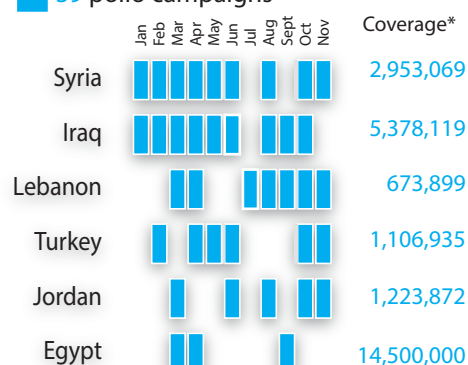
